

## PRESS RELEASE



Allied Aviation has successfully started operations in Bogotá, Colombia. Allied will be operating under the name Servicio de Aviacion Allied Bogotá, SAS ("Allied Bogotá"). Allied Bogotá will be performing Management and Operations of one of the fuel facilities as well as into-plane fueling at El Dorado International Airport (BOG). This operation expands Allied into South America, with further expansion planned early in 2013. These new operations demonstrate our ability to continue to grow our activities both domestically and internationally.

This new business venture constitutes approximately 43% of the entire airport's commercial fueling

operations. Allied's capital investment into the BOG infrastructure includes the building of a new fuel facility and hydrant system. Upon completion Allied Bogotá will operate 100% of the BOG fueling operations. Allied Bogotá is responsible for fueling over 90 flights a day and over 80 million gallons a year.



El Dorado International Airport is an international airport located in Bogotá, Colombia. It is ranked among the top 50 world's busiest airports in terms of: passenger traffic (ranked third in Latin America with 20,427,603 passengers in 2011), cargo traffic (ranked first in Latin America and 33<sup>rd</sup> worldwide with 648,221 metric tons in 2011) and traffic movements (ranked second in Latin America and 45th worldwide with 304,330 aircraft movements in 2011). As such it is the largest airport in Colombia and the main international and domestic air gateway in the country, serving as an important hub for Avianca (the national flag carrier of Colombia), Copa Airlines Colombia, LAN Colombia, Satena, EasyFly and other cargo companies. It is managed by Operadora Aeroportuaria Internacional (OPAIN), a consortium composed of Colombian construction and engineering firms and the Swiss Flughafen Zürich AG.

El Dorado is the most important airport in Colombia, accounting for 49% of the total air traffic in the country. It handles all domestic and international flights into Bogotá and boasts the world's third largest landing field 6.9 square kilometers (1,700 acres) of land.
